New Well Project:

Mayor James stated that it will be sometime in the summer before hearing if the city will be receiving the grant from East Arkansas Planning and Development that has been applied for. The grant is for up to \$200,000.00. Any grant money received will be applied on the loan the city has been approved for in the amount of \$ 527,000.00.

A decision to raise the cost of grave plots and the opening and closing cost of graves was tabled till next months meeting.

The Caraway Easter Egg will be Saturday, April 20th at 1:00 p.m. at the city park. A car show will also be held that day from 10 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the park. There will be a ball tournament held at the ball park during the day also.

The Caraway Fishing Rodeo will be held Saturday, May 4th from 8:00 a.m. till 11 a.m. at the city pond.

Patrolman David Choate reported that thirteen warnings and two tickets had been issued for non-compliance with the city clean property ordinance.
