After his presentation of his desire to recommend the hiring of Alex Edmonds, Alex took the floor and informed the mayor and council of his desire for the opportunity to serve on the Caraway Police department.

Mayor James gave the floor to Justin Clay, the new Parks Director, who reviewed work he has already done and presented his plans in leading the parks work for the coming playing season. Discussion of how he will be paid for the work was discussed with no definite plan put in place. City employees will help along with runteer workers to do the work with fields and games to be played.

Mayor James informed the council that Jeremy Garland, Brian Barnes, Travis Williams, Kyle Vaughn and Travis Emery resigned from the Park Commission.

Mayor James said he and Christy Tipton had looked at the city's insurance premiums and coverage's and made changes that resulted in approximately \$5,000.00 in savings.

The new computer company that will be replacing P.C.Doc is the Sky Blue company.

Properties brought up for attention of cleaning up included: Property on St. Louis, State and School St.

Work is continuing on the new pharmacy.

A pot hole on Asher street needs patched and Mayor James said they would take care of it.
