Others items discussed included:

Mayor James gave a report on the status of the grant request from Delta Regional Authority. The city was notified the city would not be getting the grant. Mayor James read a letter from the Arkansas Natural Resources Fiscal Manager Debra Dickson stating their recommendation for the city to approve a loan of \$327,000.00 The loan would come from the Arkansas Drinking Water Sale Revolving Loan Fund. The loan would come with a 1.75 percent interest rate on a 20 year loan term. There would also be the added condition of monthly water rates would have to be adjusted. Mayor James informed the council they needed a written response by November 13, 2019 for the loan process to remain open.

Mayor James handed out a copy of the proposed budgets for 2020 for the General, Street and Water Departments. Voting on the budgets will be during next month's city council meeting.

Merett Emery ask if it would be agreeable for the Caraway Rodeo Arena to be renamed the Roger Bell Memorial Arena. The council saw no problem with it. The announcement will be made Saturday, October 12 during a barrel e event to held that day.

Caraway Park Commissioner Jeremy Garland announced that the Caraway Fall Fest will be held on Saturday, October 26 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
