Mayor James informed the council that the grant papers had been signed for the Arkansas Community and Economics Development Grant for \$200,000.00. The mayor added that the city was still waiting to hear from the second grant from the Delta Regional Authority. Work on the new well should be starting within a few months.

Mayor James stated the city would be observing Friday, October 4th as "Go Pink Day" and encouraging citizens to wear pink in support of Breast Cancer awareness. City employs will be wearing pink and the Caraway city park will be decorated in pink for the day.

Citizens having problems with dogs running lose on Tennessee Street, Chief Kelems said they had addressed the problem and picked up the dog.

Travis Williams of the Caraway Park Commission requested approval of Caleb Waugh and Cody Richardson to the Park Commission. Willaims also ask if the city could donate \$800-\$1,000 for entertainment for the Caraway Harvest Festival. Mayor James will check with the city attorney and Arkansas Municipal League for the legality of giving the donation.

e Caraway Harvest Festival will be Saturday, October 25th, sponsored by the Caraway Park Commission.

Saturday, October 19th has been set as the day for cleanup at the Caraway city park starting at 9 a.m. Everyone is invited to come and help.

Mayor James stating there were needed repairs at the old dress factory including: leaking roof, several broken windows and a ceiling falling in. Mayor James will look into the situation to see what the timeline will be for the repairs.

Mayor James has talked to Entergy about the high cost of electricity at the city ball fields. The mayor said he would continue working on the problem with Energy.

Roger Williams expressed appreciation for the good work done by the city employees.

Cleaning up of property on San Francisco street and the ditch by the new Dollar General store was addressed.

Roger Williams made a motion to adjourn meeting, seconded by Mitchell Tipton. Motion carries on vote of 6-0.
