The meeting opened up with Mayor James introducing David Schweitzer of River City hydraulics. Mr. Schweitzer presented to the council options on the purchase/lease of a trash truck to be used by the city to collect garbage. Various options were presented as to the financing and opportunities to buy the truck outright and the end of two years of leasing. Estimates were given regarding monthly payments, trash can cost and other expenses. The Mayor said the city taking over trash pickup would require hiring a full-time employee. The employee would pickup trash one day and do other job work as needed. Mayor James ask the council to consider all the options and take it up at next month's meeting.

Mayor James gave the council the proposed budgets for the General, Street and Water & Sewer dept.'s 2022 budgets.

It was cited that last year all city employees raised a one dollar an hour raise. In addition the employees will receive \$1,500.00 from the American Recovery Funds if approved by the council. Mayor James said he would go back and look at the proposed budgets to see about possible raises in answer to a question about employee raises for the 2022 year.
