Mayor James gave a update on a request from Mr. Harrell concerning needed roof repairs on the old dress factory building he's leasing. The matter has been given over to city attorney Johnny Dunigan to look further into at this time.

The city has been on the new water well water for about three weeks now. Mayor James said the city well system has encountered some problems that could be expected after not being used the last three or four years while using the Buffalo Island system water. The repairs are being addressed by the city's water department employees.

The matter of water needing to be pumped into the city pond was discussed. Moss seems to be a problem and the mayor will look into the matter further.

There is a problem with some grass growing up through the chat on Bowen St. that needs some attention.

There was discussion about dealing with a pit bull dog around the Methodist church that poses a potential threat for harm to people. Police Chief Kelems will look into the problem.

Police Kelems also informed the council of the need of checking on a camper trailer on South New York street to determine if it is being occupied according to the city ordinance.
