The need for repair and upkeep of playground equipment was discussed and the needed funding for it.

Reimbursement for fence repairs and and a new lawn mower was approved .

There will be an auction on Saturday, October 15th to fund a scholarship in memory of Emily Utley at the Riverside East gym at 7 pm.

The issue of dog control in the city was discussed.

Adam Carpenter is supposed to give the city a bid on putting gutters back up at the old dress factory.

Properties needing cleanup were discussed with Police Chief Shannon Kelems.

Cleaning up pine needles on and around an air conditioning unit adjacent to the city hall building was discussed.

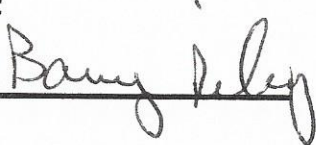
The start of more new apartments on Missouri street should begin in four weeks.
