

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-3

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY AND AMERICAN RECOVERY PLAN ACT GRANT BUDGETS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLAIMING POLICE SALARIES AND EMPLOYER PAYROLL CONTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, ARPA became law on March 11, 2021 and provides fiscal relief funds to state and local governments and other program areas aimed at mitigating the continuing effects of the COVID 19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, ARPA provides support to local governments in responding to the impact of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain COVID-19 and prescribes the uses of funding including one to address lost revenue for cities and towns ; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Treasury, has issued guidance and Final Rule regarding the use of ARPA funds; and

WHEREAS, the FINAL RULE permits cities and towns to apply ARPA grant funds up to \$10,000,000 or the total amount of a city's ARPA awarded, whichever is less, for governmental services and it expressly includes "the provision of police, fire, and other public safety services" in a list of non-exclusive enumerated uses; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Caraway City Council., that:

Section 1. The City of Caraway hereby appropriates from the City's portion of the ARPA a total amount of \$ 190,804.70 to claim police salary and employer payroll contribution expenses from the dates of March 3,2021 to March 31,2022.

Section 2. The City Council directs Rick Stevens (Recorder,Treasurer) to move the expenditures for the police and the applicable employer contributions from the city budget to Rescue Grant and to pay the city general fund for the expenses from the ARPA GRANT. The City's 2021 budget is hereby amended by decreasing the expenditures in the amount of \$ 150,023.48 and the 2021 ARPA budget is hereby amended by increasing the budget in the amount of \$ 150,023.48 for police expenses for the time period of March3, 2021 to December 31,2021. For the first quarter of 2022, the police expenses are decreased in the amount of \$ 40,781.22 and the 2022 ARPA budget increased by the same amount.

Section 3. On the mandatory Annual Report, the police and expenses shall be reported under the Expenditure Category number 6.1 entitled Revenue Replacement.
